Revision Booklets – Ordinarily, revision booklets are completed at home (over a period of 4 weeks) whilst practice papers are being completed in school, but with the unforeseen circumstances we find ourselves in, each revision booklet should be completed over a period of any four days within a week. Inside the front cover gives guidance on which sections of the booklets to complete each day.

Practice Papers – I would suggest that children should complete each paper in the morning when they are fresh. They should find a quiet area where there are no disturbances and have a clock or countdown timer close to them to keep an eye on their time.

Parental Support – To get the most out of these Transfer support resources, it is imperative that parents mark and go over revision booklets and practice papers with their children to help them to understand what they are learning and to explain where they have gone wrong when they make mistakes.
