Christmas Concert DVD: We were delighted by our children's performances before Christmas and the quality of the DVD. A few copies still remain and can be purchased from the office at £8 each.

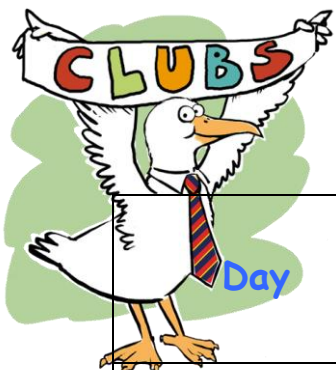
