Hexagonal Learning in Year 6 & 7: Year 6 & 7 have been introduced recently to Hexagonal Learning. It's a learning approach designed to allow our little learners to illustrate their deep understanding of a topic that they can show links to; using the six sided shapes with key words written on. You can put whatever you want onto the hexagons depending on the topic being covered. Our children use their multistructural knowledge of the topic to show the relationships between the words on each hexagon. There's no one correct way to do this; the point is that our children get to show off their deep understanding by explaining the links they have created in the topic. Here are a few photographs:
